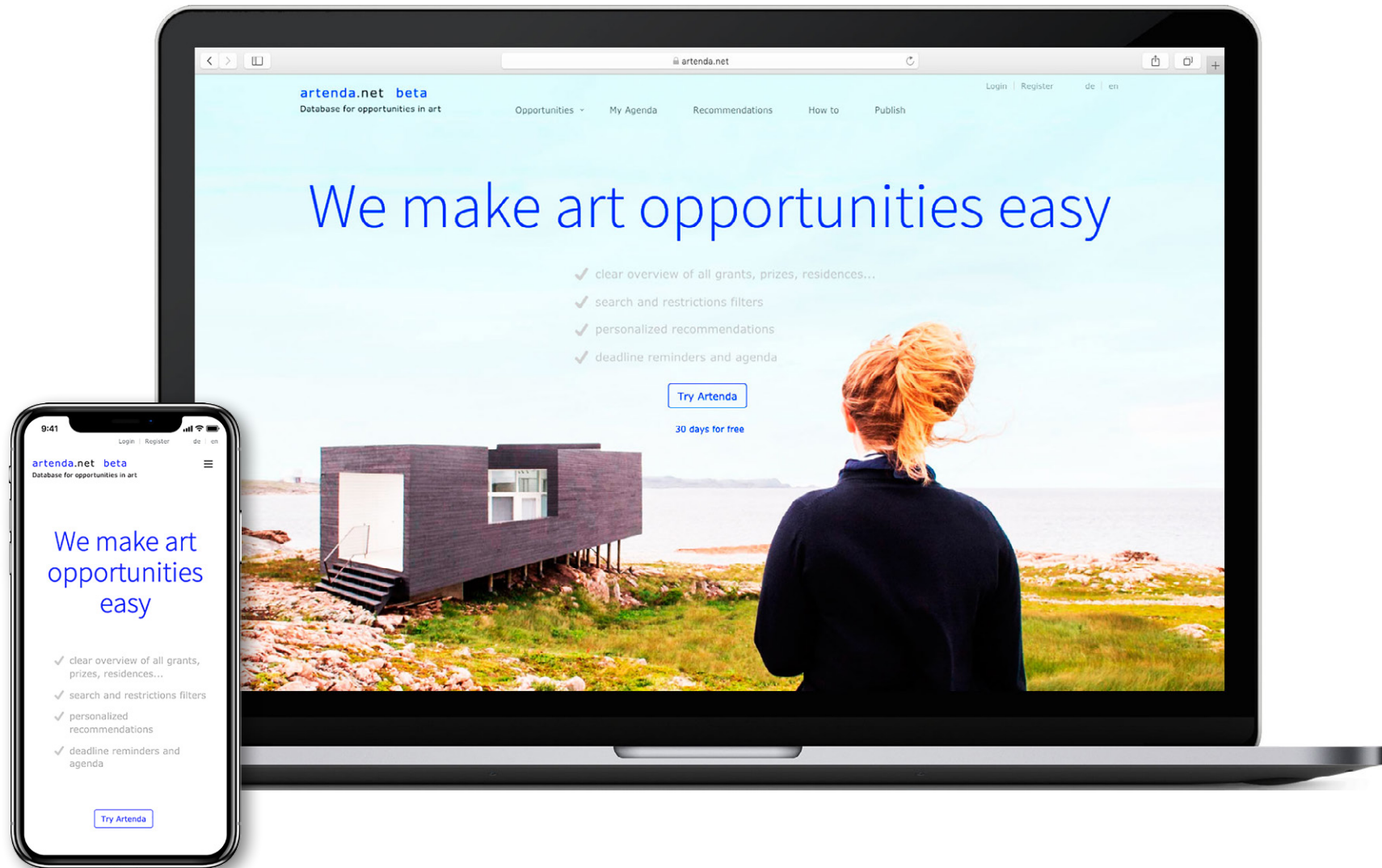

In short

Making the search quick and easy, for worldwide opportunities in the field of art – this was the idea behind Artenda.

Based on this idea, Artenda's web platform was created in spring 2019.

Artenda's website provides artists with an indispensable tool for navigating through the multitude of art opportunities, and supports them to successfully apply.

Why

Competitions, grants and residencies are key for artists to get the attention and financial support they need to develop their work.

The founder, who is an artist himself, noticed that the search for art opportunities is very laborious: calls for tenders are spread in a confusing way over a large number of websites, information is difficult to find, and it often turns out that the calls do not match one's profile or that the deadline has already passed.

He came across well-structured websites for architecture-related competitions and asked himself why there was no such thing for the field of art. He imagined how the ideal tool for artists would look like, a tool he always hoped to find. On this basis, he founded the start-up Artenda.

How

Artenda's website provides a clear overview of all international art opportunities: scholarships, competitions, project grants, residencies, exhibitions, and public art projects.

A long search to find out whether the calls are interesting or if the application profile matches one's work is no longer needed. The website presents all information in a clear and directly accessible way, so that the users do not lose time any more. In addition, the search is facilitated, accelerated, and personalized by the means of filters.

Furthermore, Artenda helps artists through the way it selects and presents tenders: recommendations are personalized, there is a personal agenda with deadline reminders, and tips provide ideas for a successful application. Artenda makes it easy to focus on the key aspects of the search.

The website and the specially developed tools are provided on a monthly subscription basis.
